Measure Set: Alignment with Attributes

The Purchaser Business Group on Health's (PBGH) California Quality Collaborative (CQC) has articulated attributes of advanced primary care, which result in high quality, high value primary care with patients at the center of every interaction.

To help identify practices having implemented these <u>attributes</u>, CQC, the Integrated Healthcare Association and stakeholders defined a measure set focused on patient health outcomes and experience of care.
