1. As part of CQC's Behavioral Health Integration – Children and Youth Collaborative Learning Exchange, organizations will identify an improvement project to work on in the course of the collaborative. Can you confirm what project you will be working on?

We want to provide deidentified ACE screening to patients age 12+ during Well Child Checks. This project will include training office staff and a workflow for addressing elevated ACE scores.

2. How will you measure success of the project?

There is currently no screening in our Santa Rosa pediatric office. Unfortunately, Epic does not have PEARLs integrated into documentation, so we will manually track screenings.

3. What are key milestones you can plan for in the course of the project?

- a. Training staff, b. Including screening into WCCs for 12+, c. receiving responses and warm hand offs for elevated scores
- b. What barriers do you anticipate?

Buy-in from staff will be a barrier, we are hoping education and support will help. Access to the BHP may also be a barrier, as she is much busier than anyone anticipated.
